As a matter of fact, from the moment we brought him home, the phrase we find ourselves repeating is, "He is so gentle." He moves quietly; he plays with his toys gently; he snuggles up to us gently; he is just a very well-mannered, sweet dog.

Willy's behavior came to my mind the other day as I was studying through 1 Peter. Yes, you did read that correctly. In chapter 3, Peter is giving instruction to both wives and husbands in how we are to behave and live with one another. In verse 4, we read, but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious. Now, I know that Peter is addressing wives at this point, but we also know from scripture that gentleness is a behavior we should all exhibit:

- Philippians 4:5 Let your gentleness be known to all.
- Titus 3:5 ...to be peaceable, gentle, showing every consideration for all men;
- Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger;
- Galatians 5:23 But the fruit of the Spirit is...gentleness.

As we examine our own behavior, are we living like those of the world or are we living like Willy? Ha-ha. Seriously though, are we living like Jesus? Gentleness is a character trait of Christ that we ought to strive to emulate every single day. Unfortunately, it is sometimes hard to distinguish those in our communities who are Christ-followers and those who live for self. As disciples of Christ, I encourage you to practice gentleness and see how others might take notice. The world around us makes a continuous practice of harshness and hardness, and as our culture becomes more impatient, less tolerant, and void of Christ's influence, our gentle behavior may impact others more than you realize.

My challenge to you this month is to be gentle. It won't always be easy, but I can assure you,"...a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious" (1 Peter 3:4), won't go unnoticed.
