### What Is Life?

Every so often it's worth asking a simple but profound question: What is life? The world tells us it's about success, comfort, or pleasure. But God's Word points us to something much deeper.

Life begins with God. In Genesis 2:7 we see Him forming Adam from the dust and breathing into him the breath of life. Isaiah 64:8 reminds us that He is the Potter and we are the clay. You and I are not accidents, we were carefully shaped by God's hands, made with purpose, and filled with His breath.

Life is not just about the physical. Jesus said in Matthew 6:25 that life is more than food and the body more than clothes. Those things matter, but they do not define us. True life comes from trusting the One who provides.

Scripture also reminds us that life is brief. James 4:14 describes it as a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. That truth may sound sobering, but it should stir us to live each day intentionally, with gratitude and with eternity in mind.

And here's the hope we cling to: real life is spiritual and eternal. Jesus said in John 14:6, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life." Eternal life is not simply endless existence, it is knowing God personally through Jesus Christ, just as He prayed in John 17:3. By His grace, we are made alive with Christ, even when we were dead in sin, as Ephesians 2:4–5 declares.

Finally, life in Christ is full. Jesus promised in John 10:10, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." That doesn't mean longer days or easier years, but deeper joy, lasting peace, and eternal purpose.

So, what is life? It is God's gift; brief, precious, eternal, and fulfilled in Christ alone. Let's live each day gratefully in Him.
